



Peace Corps visioning potluck Feb. 11, 2025

On February 11, 2025, members of the Central Missouri RPCV group, their families, and friends gathered in the Friends' room of the COlumbia Public LIbrary for a potluck and Peace Corpse-style visioning session. The goal of the event was "to discuss our vision for the Mid-Mo RPCV group: What is the future of this organization? What are we willing to contribute to make our vision reality?" More than 25 community members participated in the event.

After dining, we reviewed the group's mission, vision, and goals, and engaged in a participatory facilitated discussion to enumerate and prioritize the group's activities. This document summarizes the results of that process and makes recommendations for action.

Recommendation: Based on our visioning session, we recommend that the Central Missouri RPCV group update the bylaws to reflect the top priorities of the current group members:

1. Connect with other Mid-Mo RPCVs through regular gatherings
2. Service to the Mid-Mo community and to the PC community
3. Promote Peace Corps locally/ nationally
